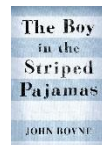
// The power of literature

Read their reviews, find book recommendations, comment or add your own review in their Book Group Forum:

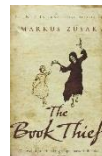

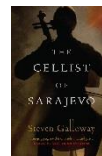
