This quick guide shows at a glance what Further Education (FE) Funding is available and who can apply.

Funding is subject to certain qualifying criteria as defined by Scottish Funding Council policies with regard to Further Education Funds. This includes residency requirements, parental/spouse income and any previous funding received.

If you have previously received Bursary Support from any college you may initially be refused funding.

Please check with the Student Funding Team at the relevant campus to determine if you are eligible.
