## **Childcare Funding**

(HNC and HND)

This quick guide offers information for students who would like to apply for assistance with formal childcare costs and fall into the following categories:

- > Must have dependent child
- Must have applied for all available support from Student Award Agency Scotland (SAAS) including Student Loan and supplementary grants
- Must be paying for registered childcare costs to allow you to attend college as per your agreed timetable or for placement days that are a mandatory part of your course
- Must meet the eligibility criteria for Tuition Fees to be considered for assistance from the childcare fund. Lone parents can be considered for the Lone Parent Childcare Grant even if they are not eligible for Tuition Fee Support

Fully completed applications with all supporting documents must be received within 4 weeks of the start date of the course. Please be advised your award will only be calculated from the date your application is deemed complete.
