
The HIVE makes education accessible to all!


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Why choose The HIVE?

You'll get direction in your life. If you think you don't offer much or don't have a clue what you want to do, our courses will help you realise your potential and assist you in following your dreams.





The HIVE focuses on preparing young people (up to the age of 24) for life, learning and work. Our courses are designed to help you develop your confidence, social skills and independence, in a place where you will feel comfortable and supported.



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Start here...

We have designed courses to meet the needs of a range of young people who come to The HIVE. Our 24/7 and 24/7 Plus courses are for 15-16 year olds and are all about developing 'soft skills' and finding out what they're good at.

PEZ (which stands for the Personal Empowerment Zone) and PEZ Plus take that a step further by deciding which career path you should take while continuing to develop your essential skills.

The Prince's Trust is a 12-week personal development programme that involves working on a community project, gaining work experience and enjoying a residential trip. Each course has an element of classroom work alongside project-based work.
